Professional Valeting and Detailing – What to Look For

1. History and Experience

Don't be fooled by a low price or outrageous price. A Valeter/Detailer with a proper business history and experience knows what the correct price should be for their expert work. They have confronted every obstacle and know instinctively what is needed to solve the problem. Like hiring any professional, look to their credentials and affiliations.

2. Selection of Products

Make sure that the Detailer you have chosen does not use harsh chemicals to clean your car (inside or out). You want to find someone who uses natural car care products. Natural products will not damage the paint on your vehicle. Also, you should check into whether the Detailer is trained, authorized and fully licensed to use, and advertise use of the products they will be detailing your automobile with. The best way to do this is to contact the manufacturer of the products. They should be able to tell you whether or not they are factory trained.

3. Customer Service

Wouldn't you like to be treated as nicely as your car will be treated? A Detailer should offer world class customer service as well as a professional look to their shop, van and person.

4. Layout and Design of Detailer Location

Look for a Detailer location that is spacious. If there does not seem to be a lot of room in between bays or parking spots there is a chance of accidental damage that can occur. Maneuvering around a vehicle while detailing it requires a good amount of space. If there is barely enough room to walk between cars there is definitely not enough room to detail between cars.

5. Cleanliness

If the Detailer or their staff is not clean you cannot expect your automobile to come out looking pristine either. Cleanliness all the way around goes hand in hand with the cleanliness of your vehicle.

6. Services
